COVID-19 Message
Updated: September 21, 2021**

Emmet County has moved to risk Level E. Risk Level E is the highest level risk determination, indicating there are 150 or more cases per million population.

Friendship Centers of Emmet County, Council on Aging, is modifying or canceling some services as shown below, effective immediately:

1. Congregate Meals - Indoor dining is canceled effective immediately. Due to not enough participation of curb-side meal delivery, this will not be offered at this time.
2. Enrichment Programs - Outdoor activities can continue, as long as seniors are appropriately distanced. Indoor activities are canceled until further notice. Fitness programs are accessible on our website and Facebook pages.
3. Volunteer Activities - We will not have any RSVP volunteers on site until further notice. Volunteers may continue to serve at their own discretion or that of the station.
4. In-Home Services - In-home services are being reinstated beginning Monday, October 4, 2021.
5. Bus Services - Transportation will continue with existing PPE requirements, social distancing, and cleaning protocols continuing.
6. Foot Care - Foot Care appointments will continue, however, all clients must remain masked for the entire time they are in the building.
7. Meals on Wheels - Meals on Wheels services will continue.

Because Emmet County is at Level E, please be especially careful to wear masks when out in public, wash or disinfect your hands frequently and avoid touching your face.
